About Prerana:

Prerana is a civil society organisation that started its work in 1986 by addressing the issue of intergenerational trafficking into the sex trade in Kamathipura, the then largest red-light area in Asia. Prerana strives to ensure optimum protection of children. This is reflected in the broad spectrum of interventions that provide a continuum of care by addressing issues of child sexual abuse in parallel with anti-human trafficking. Since its establishment in 1986, Prerana's pioneering efforts have been instrumental in supporting victims through the entire cycle from prevention to repatriation. Over a period of three decades, Prerana has been successful in addressing larger issues around sex trafficking, gender-based violence, child sexual abuse and child protection and has been instrumental in bringing policy level changes through their strong advocacy.

About Sanmaan:

Project SANMAAN (which means dignity) aims to enable children found begging in the streets of Mumbai to enjoy their rights and be free of exploitation. This project focuses on improving systemic response to children engaged in begging by demonstrating and building capacities for rights based intervention with children. The project aims to strengthen the families/communities to ensure that children receive appropriate care and protection by families (for instance, are sent to schools and not engaged in begging) and thereby prevent institutionalisation by the juvenile justice system.

Job Summary:

We are looking for a passionate, dynamic, self-motivated individual to play a pivotal role in the growth of a leading NGO working in the field of child rights and child protection. **Female candidates preferred.**

Duties and Responsibilities -

- Conducting regular community outreach visits in different communities under the project.
- Conducting school visits to seek regular updates on the children and their performance.
- Ensuring that children and their families avail facilities and services meant for them
- Identifying dropouts and taking measures to curb them
- Liaison with community groups

- Assisting the project co-ordinators.
- Attending to emergencies and responding to crisis situation
- Refer youth, children and women to government and private health facilities such as VCTC, DOTS centres, hospitals, banks, schools and educational institutions
- Assisting the project team in planning and organising events
- Assisting the project team in conducting LSE and leadership sessions wherever necessary
- You might also be needed to contribute in other tasks as and when the need may arise
- Providing assistance in documentation
- The job would involve extensive field- work

Qualifications and Experience:

- Applicant should preferably have a minimum of 1 year experience working with a field-based organisation however, new entrants too can apply.
- Should be a BSW or have a paraprofessional social work training.
- Good communication skills in Hindi, English and preferably Marathi.
